WHO CAN REGISTER?

The extranet system is restricted to the participants of UIC railway projects and activities.

Your request will be carefully verified and validated by our services.
If you don't comply with these requirements it will be refused.

During the next step, you will have to indicate your fields of activity and the working groups you are involved in, this information is very important for us, to give you access to the proper resources.

The UIC Extranet KMS tool is optimised for Internet Explorer 10, Firefox 17 and above, Chrome 32

1. ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS

UIC welcomes you. UIC provides its service to you subject to the following Terms & Conditions ("T&C"), which may be updated by us from time to time without notice to you. You can review the most current version of the T&C at any time. In addition, when using particular UIC owned or operated services, you and UIC shall be subject to any posted guidelines or rules applicable to such services, which may be posted from time to time. All such guidelines or rules (including but not limited to our Spam Policy) are hereby incorporated by reference into the T&C.

2. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

The UIC extranet provides users with access to a rich collection of resources, including various communications tools, search services, personalized content through its network.

You also understand and agree that the Service may include certain communications from UIC such as service announcements, administrative messages and Newsletter, and that these communications are considered part of UIC extranet membership and you will be able to opt out of receiving them.

Unless explicitly stated otherwise, any new features that augment or enhance the current Service, the UIC assumes no responsibility for the timeliness, deletion, mis-delivery or failure to store any user communications or personalization settings. You are responsible for obtaining access to the Service, and that access may involve third-party fees (such as Internet service provider or airtime charges). You are responsible for those fees, including those fees associated with the display or delivery of advertisements. In addition, you must provide and are responsible for all equipment necessary to access the Service.

3. YOUR REGISTRATION OBLIGATIONS

In consideration of your use of the Service, you represent that you are of legal age to form a binding contract and are not a person barred from receiving services under the laws of the United States or other applicable jurisdiction. You also agree to: (a) provide true, accurate, current and complete information about yourself as prompted by the Service's registration form (the "Registration Data") and (b) maintain and promptly update the Registration Data to keep it true, accurate, current and complete. 4. UIC PRIVACY POLICY

The Extranet system is a workspace open only to UIC Working Groups participants and as such, data processing on it is subject to a declaration to the French Data Protection Authority (CNIL) as required by Article 27-II-4° of the Data Protection Act of 6 January 1978 (amended).

5. MEMBER ACCOUNT, PASSWORD AND SECURITY

You will receive a password and account designation upon completing the Service's registration process. You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of the password and account and are fully responsible for all activities that occur under your password or account. You agree to (a) immediately notify UIC of any unauthorized use of your password or account or any other breach of security, and (b) ensure that you exit from your account at the end of each session. UIC cannot and will not be liable for any loss or damage arising from your failure to comply with this Section.

6. MEMBER CONDUCT

You understand that all information, data, text, software, sound, photographs, graphics, video, messages, tags or other materials ("Content"), whether publicly posted or privately transmitted, are the sole responsibility of the person from whom such Content originated. This means that you, and not UIC, are entirely responsible for all Content that you upload, post, email, transmit or otherwise make available via the Service. UIC does not control the Content posted via the Service and, as such, does not guarantee the accuracy, integrity or quality of such Content. You understand that by using the Service, you may be exposed to Content that is offensive, indecent or objectionable. Under no circumstances will UIC be liable in any way for any Content, including, but not limited to, any errors or omissions in any Content, or any loss or damage of any kind incurred as a result of the use of any Content posted, emailed, transmitted or otherwise made available via the Service.

However, with respect to Content you submit or make available for inclusion on publicly accessible areas of the Service, you grant UIC the following worldwide, royalty-free and non-exclusive license(s), as applicable:

* With respect to photos, graphics, audio or video you submit or make available for inclusion on publicly accessible area of the Service, the license to use, distribute, reproduce, modify, adapt, publicly perform and publicly display such Content on the Service solely for the purpose for which such Content was submitted or made available.
